(State Vs. Dilip Dnyandev Babar)

ORDER BELOW EXH.56

(Passed on this 04th day of September 2025)

1] Instant application (**Exh.56**) has been filed for grant of permission for renewal of passport to the concerned authority. He is intending to go abroad for his tour purpose. He is holding Passport bearing No. C6505031. Passport has been already issued to the present applicant **Dilip Dnyandev Babar** for the period 08.01.2025 to 07.01.2026. He is prosecuted for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 148, 149, 326, 324, 332 and 353 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 135 of the Bombay Police Act & Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act in Crime No. 94/2007 registered with police station, Bhuinj. According to him, bail has been granted to him. Present matter is fixed for hearing. He is permanent resident of Udtare, Tal.Wai, Dist.Satara. Due to pendency of criminal case, it is essential for him to seek the permission for renewal of passport. Therefore, he requested to allow application [Exh.56].

2] Learned Public Prosecutor Shri D.S.Patil has opposed said application by adopting say filed by Investigating Officer vide **Exh.61** and submitted that accused is facing trial under serious offence. There is every possibility that he will stay in foreign country, in case, application Exh.56 is allowed. As such, he will abscond. Hence, it is requested to reject the

application.

3] I have heard both the parties. Present applicant appears to have been released on bail. Both the parties have submitted that while granting bail to such applicant, no condition has been imposed about not leaving India. Basic root of applicant appears to be lying in Udtare, Wai, District Satara. He has filed his affidavit vide **Exh.57**. Therefore, there appears to be least chances of his absconding. Apart from this, applicant has every right to renew for passport. Applicant assures that he will not misuse the order, in case, application [Exh.56] is allowed. In such circumstances, I did not find any legal ground so as to reject his application. As such, if permission is granted for renewal passport to the applicant, then it may not prejudice to the prosecution side. In consequence of this, application [Exh.56] is liable to be allowed. In the result, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1] Application (Exh.56) is allowed.
- 2] Applicant/accused **Dilip Dnyandev Babar**, age 62 years, resident of Udtare, Wai, Taluka- Wai, District, Satara, is permitted for renewal of his Passport No. C6505031.
- 3] Applicant/accused should take prior permission of the Court, if he intends to travel beyond India.
