Order Below Exh.1 in Arbitration Darkhast No.71/2024

The D.H. and learned advocate for D.H. are absent today when repeatedly called. The darkhast is filed for recovery of money on the basis of arbitration award.

2. On 02.03.2026, it was directed to the D.H. to satisfy this Court as to the maintainability of the present execution petition in view of Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Bhadra International (India) Pvt. Ltd. & Ors. Vs. Airports Authority of India, 2026 INSC 6** and Judgment of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in the case of **L&T Finance Ltd. Vs. Sangeeta Bansali & Anr., 2026:BHC-OS:1426**. In spite of giving direction, the D.H. failed to argue and satisfy. The present execution petition is more than 02 years old. Further, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed to dispose of the pending execution petitions within six months. The conduct of D.H. shows that D.H. is not interested in prosecuting the petition. Therefore, no purpose would be served to keep this execution petition pending. Hence, I pass the following order :

ORDER

The execution petition is dismissed in default for want of prosecution.
