Vishal Nanaware & Ors. Vs. State

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.04

1] This is an application submitted by accused **Vishal Sahebrao Nanaware** and **Kiran Shivaji Bankar** for releasing them on ad-interim anticipatory bail under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (In short, 'BNSS').

2] Heard Ld. Advocate Shri. N.R.Randive for both accused. Perused record. It has been submitted by Advocate for accused that, both accused are having apprehension of arrest in connection with C.R.No. 77 of 2026 registered in Phaltan Rural Police Station under Sections 108, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023. They are responsible bank officers therefore they may kindly be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail.

3] In this case F.I.R. on record shows that, deceased Suraj Ankush Sonawane the brother of complainant Sudesh Ankush Sonawane has committed suicide on the reason that, both accused have made allegation of theft against him. It appears from FIR that suicide note mentioning names of both accused is found in the pocket of shirt of the deceased. After registration of this crime

investigation officer has applied Section 3(2) (v) of Schedule Cast and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989. Therefore, considering all above stated facts and gravity of the alleged offence before granting anticipatory bail it is necessary to hear prosecution and complainant. Hence, both accused are not entitled for ad-interim anticipatory bail at this stage.

4] Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

Application at Exh. 04 is hereby rejected.
