**Jagannath Jadhav Vs. State**  
(Phaltan Rural Police Station C. R. No.78/2026)

**ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.04.**

(Dtd.23.02.2026)

1] This is an application preferred by accused **Jagannath Baburao Jadhav** for releasing him on ad-interim anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023.

2] Heard Ld. Advocate Shri. S. S. Kamble for accused. In support of this application Advocate for accused has kept his reliance on case **Anas A. S. Vs. State of Kerala, 2025 Supreme (Online)Ker) 37506, 2025 KER 45696** in which it has been observed by Hon'ble Kerala High Court at Ernakulam that, " *11. Having regard to the nature of allegations and the injuries inflicted on the de facto complainant and her husband, I am of the view that though the allegations are serious in nature, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary, however, for the recovery of the weapons, limited custody can be granted as held in Sushila Aggarwal and Others (supra).*

3] In this case C. R. No. 78 of 2026 is registered against this accused along with another accused in Phaltan Rural Police Station under Section 351(2), 352, 119(1), 3(5) of BNS on the complaint of one Manoj Sambhaji Tambe. It is alleged that on 06.02.2026 at about 11:30 p.m., this accused along with another accused Jotiram Bankar have demanded amount with complainant for consuming liquor. On

refusal by complainant, this accused Jagannath Bapurao Jadhav abused the complainant, another accused Jotiram Tatyaram Bankar caught hold complainant from back side and this accused Jagannath slapped him. At that time this accused Jagannath Jadhav snatched Rs.7,300/- from the pocket of complainant. Hence, the offence.

4] In this case, this accused Jagannath is of 60 years. Advocate for accused produced copy of order published by District Collector, Satara dated. 03.02.2026 on record along with Exh.6 at serial no. 3 which shows that Collector, Satara has ordered to close all kinds of wine shop during the period 06.02.2026 to 09.02.2026. Considering facts of the alleged offence immediate custodial interrogation with accused is not necessary. As far as, question of recovery of amount of Rs.7,300/- is concerned, condition can be imposed on accused to attend Phaltan Rural Police Station for interrogation. For all above stated reasons and in view of ratio laid down in above cited reported case law, it will be just and proper to grant ad interim anticipatory bail to accused.

5] Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

### **ORDER**

- 1) Ad-interim anticipatory bail application at Exh.04 is hereby allowed.
- 2) In the event of arrest in connection with C.R.No.78/2026 registered in Phaltan Rural Police Station for the offence punishable

under Sections 351(2), 352, 119(1), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, accused **Jagannath Bapurao Jadhav** be released on P.B. and S.B. of Rs.25,000/- and on following conditions:-

i) That accused shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.

ii) That accused shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.

iii) That accused shall attend the Phaltan Rural police station as and when called by Investigation officer, till completion of investigation.
