

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN SPECIAL (POCSO) CASE NO. 108/2024

(CNR No. - MHST21000219-2024)

(Abhijeet @ Aba Ramdas Godse Vs. The State of Maharashtra)

Today three witnesses Sudhir Pandurang Padase, Dilip Sampat Nimbale and Sachin Vinayak Mind are present. The Ld. Prosecutor Shri. M.H.Oak and the Ld. Advocate Shri. R. K. Dhaigude for accused are present.

02. The accused is produced through Video Conferencing at 3:45 PM. In between for less than half minute, the network was hanged from the jail at Kalamba. Therefore, the accused is complaining that he is unable to hear the conversation through Video Conferencing. He also complained that on 07.04.2024, he has been shifted to Central Prison, Kalamba from Central Prison, Satara. He requested for his attendance in the Court while recording evidence. He is also submitting that he has made applications under the Right to Information Act to some authorities.

03. It appears that the accused is of complaining nature and therefore to avoid further complications and unwarranted allegations from the accused, the further evidence requires to be recorded in his presence.

04. The reason for shifting the accused from Satara to Kalamba Prison is best known to the Jail Authorities. However, considering the necessity of presence of the accused before Court, Superintendent of Prison at Kalamba is directed to shift the accused in the Central Prison, Satara and the Superintendent, Central Prison, Satara is directed to get him admitted in prison at Satara.

05. Both the jail authorities are directed to monitor behaviour of the accused during the period of his stay in the prison and to report the

same to the Court fortnightly. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] The accused produced before the Court while recording the prosecution evidence.
- 2] The Superintendent, Central Prison, Kalamba is directed to shift the accused **Abhijeet @ Aba Ramdas Godse** to the Central Prison, Satara.
- 3] The Superintendent of both the prisons, Kalamba and Satara are directed to record daily, the behaviour of accused during his stay in the prison and report the same fortnightly to this Court.
- 4] In the above circumstances, the above said witnesses are bond over for further appearance on the next date.
