Respondent No.2 insurer to pay to the petitioner amount of Rs.26,00,000/- towards full and final settlement.




The parties are informed that the court fee, if any, paid by any of them shall be refunded.



AWARD

1. Respondent No.2 insurer to pay to the petitioners amount of **Rs.26,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Six Lakhs Only)** towards full and final settlement.
2. Respondent No.2 insurer shall deposit this amount with the Tribunal within 30 days failing which it shall carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum on the said amount from the date of this award till its full realization.
3. Petitioner No.1 shall get the amount of Rs.16,00,000/- (Rupees Sixteen Lakhs Only), out of the total compensation.
4. Amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) from the share of petitioner No.1 shall be kept in fixed deposit in any nationalized bank for the period of three years. Thereafter, he would be entitled to withdraw it along with the accrued interest thereon.
5. The petitioner No.2 shall be entitled to get the amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only), and this amount shall be invested in fixed deposit in her name in any nationalized bank, till she attains majority, and thereafter, she would be entitled to withdraw it alongwith the accrued interest.
6. Petitioners are entitled to get refund full court-fees which they have paid.
