Order below Exh.1 in M.A.C.P No.483/2025

Perused mediation report at Exh.25 and compromise pursis at Exh.23.

2. The claimant Nos.1, 3 and 4 alongwith their advocate are present before the Court. The claimants are identified by their learned Advocate. In view of mediation report, Exh.25 and compromise pursis at Exh.23 claimants have fully and finally settled their dispute with opponent No.2 for sum of **Rs.24,90,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Four Lakh Ninety Thousand Only)**. Consequently, opponent No.1 – owner is exonerated from liability. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1.	Petition stands disposed of in view of compromise through mediation.
2.	Opponent No.2- Insurance Company do deposit settlement amount of Rs.24,90,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Four Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) within period of one month from the date of award , in bank account of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thane, by RTGS or NEFT, as per directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Writ Petition No. 534/2020.
3.	If Opponent No.2 fails to comply, settlement amount shall carry interest @ 8% p.a. from the date of award till its actual realization.
4.	Out of compensation amount given to claimants, Rs.12,90,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) be given to claimant No.1, Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Only) be given to claimant No.2 and Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) each be given to the claimant Nos.3 and 4.

5.	Out of compensation given to claimant No.1, Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Only) be invested in fixed deposit for the period of 2 years, in her name, in any Nationalized Bank.
6.	Compensation amount given to claimant No.2 be invested in fixed deposit in his name, in any Nationalized Bank, till he attains majority.
7.	The branch manager of concerned bank is directed to pay the amount of fixed deposit with interest to concerned claimants after its maturity without asking further order of this Tribunal for its realization.
8.	Remaining compensation amount be transferred by RTGS or NEFT - i) in the account No.038801000035206 of claimant No.1 maintained at Indian Overseas Bank, Branch – Delisle Road, Mumbai, having IFSC Code – IOBA0000388. Her Aadhar card number is 472538434546 and PAN card number is GPMPK9387H, ii) in the account No.3683108001199 of claimant No.3 maintained at Canara Bank, Branch – Asoi Lacchi Ram, Bhagwanpur, Dist.Vaishali, Bihhar, having IFSC Code – CNRB0003683. His Aadhar card number is 781741012519 and PAN card number is CFUPD5282C, iii) in the account No.038801000035205 of claimant No.4 maintained at Indian Overseas Bank, Branch – Delisle Road, Mumbai, having IFSC Code – IOBA0000388. Her Aadhar card number is 631210262375 and PAN card number is CJLPD4268H, as per award.
9.	Court fees be refunded to the claimants as per rule.
10.	Award be drawn up accordingly.
