Perused mediation report at Exh.22 and compromise pursis at Exh.20.

2. The claimant alongwith his Advocate and Advocate for opponent No.2 are present before the court. The claimant is identified by his learned Advocate. In view of mediation report Exh.22 and compromise pursis at Exh.20 claimant has fully and finally settled his dispute with opponent No.2 for sum of **Rs.6,45,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh Forty-Five Thousand Only)**. Consequently, opponent No.1 – owner is exonerated from liability. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1.	Petition stands disposed of in view of compromise through mediation.
2.	Opponent No.2- Insurance Company do deposit settlement amount of Rs.6,45,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh Forty-Five Thousand Only) within period of one month from the date of award , in bank account of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thane, by RTGS or NEFT, as per directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Writ Petition No. 534/2020.
3.	If Opponent No.2 fails to comply, settlement amount shall carry interest @ 8% p.a. from the date of award till its actual realization.
4.	Compensation amount be paid by RTGS or NEFT - in the account No.001110000041402 of claimant maintained at

	Sindhudurg Sahakari Bank Ltd., Mumbai Branch – Lalbaug, Mumbai, having IFSC Code – UTIBOSSIND1. His Aadhar card number is 379556748219 and PAN card number is AQCPB1098D, as per award.
5.	The opponent No.2 is directed to inform in writing to the claimant and the Tribunal after depositing the amount in M.A.C.T. Account by mentioning claim petition number, date of depositing amount, the amount, UTR number of NEFT or RTGS transaction and name of claimant.
6.	Court fees be refunded to the claimant as per rule.
7.	Award be drawn up accordingly.
