

3.	Opponent- Insurance Company shall deposit settlement amount of <b>Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Only)</b> including amount of N.F.L., <b>within period of one month from the date of award</b> , in bank account of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thane, by RTGS or NEFT, as per directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Writ Petition No.534/2020.
4.	If it fails to comply as per Clause 2 above, <b>settlement amount shall carry interest @ 8% p.a. from the date of award till its actual realization.</b>
5.	Out of compensation amount given to claimant, <b>Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only)</b> be invested in fixed deposit for 3 years, in his name in any nationalized bank, as per his choice.
6.	The branch manager of concerned bank is directed to pay the amount of fixed deposit with interest to concerned claimant after its maturity without asking further order of this Tribunal for its realization.
7.	The claimant shall furnish his bank accounts details to this office by filing authenticate copy of passbook/ Bank documents.
8.	Remaining compensation amount be given to the claimant by account payee cheque in his bank accounts, as per award.
9.	Court fee be refunded to the claimant, as per rule.
