Order below Exh.1 in M.A.C.P No.1740/2024

Perused mediation report at Exh.21 and compromise pursis at Exh.19.

2. The claimants alongwith their Advocate and Advocate for opponent No.2 are present before the court. The claimants are identified by their learned Advocate. In view of mediation report Exh.21 and compromise pursis at Exh.19 claimants have fully and finally settled their dispute with opponent No.2 for sum of **Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh Only)**. Consequently, opponent No.1 – owner is exonerated from liability. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

1.	Petition stands disposed of in view of compromise through mediation.
2.	Opponent No.2- Insurance Company do deposit settlement amount of Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh Only) within period of one month from the date of award , in bank account of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Thane, by RTGS or NEFT, as per directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Writ Petition No. 534/2020.
3.	If Opponent No.2 fails to comply, settlement amount shall carry interest @ 8% p.a. from the date of award till its actual realization.
4.	Out of compensation amount, Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Only) each be given to claimant Nos.1 to 3.
5.	Compensation amount be paid by RTGS or NEFT -

	<p>i) in the joint account No.0495104000298483 of claimant Nos.1 and 3 maintained at IDBI Bank, Branch – Jambhali Naka, Thane (W.), having IFSC Code – IBKL0000495. Aadhar card number of claimant No.1 is 690660844875 and PAN card number is BDSPB5390L and Aadhar card number of claimant No.3 is 915823014550 and PAN card number is AQGPB7553E,</p> <p>ii) in the account No.24610169036 of claimant No.2 maintained at Standard Chartered Bank, Branch – Thane, having IFSC Code – SCBL0036068. His Aadhar card number is 921631708000 and PAN card number is AKQPB6405N, as per award.</p>
6.	The opponent No.2 is directed to inform in writing to the claimants and the Tribunal after depositing the amount in M.A.C.T. Account by mentioning claim petition number, date of depositing amount, the amount, UTR number of NEFT or RTGS transaction and name of claimants.
7.	Court fees be refunded to the claimants as per rule.
8.	Award be drawn up accordingly.
