*This suit came before me for final hearing in the presence of **Sri T. Krishna Mohan Rao, Counsel for Plaintiffs** and of **Defendant Nos.1 and 2 are set exparte** and upon having hearing the and on perusal of the material on record and the matter having stood over for consideration till this day, the court delivered the following:*

:: JUDGMENT ::

1. This suit is filed by the plaintiffs for the relief of declaration to declare the plaintiffs No.1 to 4 as the legal heirs of deceased Allam Jangaiah, S/o. Late Allam Mallaiah.

The brief averments of the plaint are as follows:

2. The plaintiffs filed the present plaint by stating that the plaintiff No.1 is the son, plaintiff No.2 is the wife, plaintiffs No.3 and 4 are the daughters of Allam Jangaiah who died on 10.01.2026 leaving behind the plaintiffs as his legal heirs. After death of Allam Jangaiah, the plaintiffs approached the defendant No.1 to obtain legal heir certificate, but they refused to issue the same and advised the plaintiffs to approach the competent court. As such, the plaintiffs filed this suit.

3. The defendant No.1 did not appear before the court inspite of service of summons and hence defendant No.1 was set exparte. No objections received for the paper publication and hence defendant No. 2 was set exparte.

4. During the course of plaintiffs' evidence, Plaintiff No.1 was examined as PW-1 and Exs.A1 to A7 got marked.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the plaintiffs. Perused the material on record.

6. Now the point for determination is ***“whether the suit can be decreed as prayed for”?***

POINT:

7. The plaintiff No.1 examined as PW1 and filed chief affidavit in lieu of his chief-examination wherein he has reiterated the averments of the plaint. He got marked the death certificate of the deceased Allam Jangaiah as Ex.A1, which shows that he died on 10.01.2026. Further, Ex.A2 to A7 would support the case of the plaintiffs as regards their relationship with the deceased Allam Jangaiah. Thus, from the oral evidence of PW-1 and the documents Exs.A1 to A7 the plaintiffs could prove their case about the relationship with Allam Jangaiah. This evidence stood unrebutted and unchallenged. Therefore, the plaintiffs are entitled to be declared as legal heirs of Late Allam Jangaiah. The point is answered accordingly.

8. **In the result**, the suit is decreed, without costs, declaring that plaintiffs No.1 to 4 are the legal heirs of Late Allam Jangaiah S/o. Allam Mallaiah for the purpose of legal status only.
