**ORDER BELOW EXH. 127 IN R.C.S. NO. 91/2013**

**(Shri Yatindra Ramesh Nirgun Vs. 1.shri Sadguru Shri Smarth  
Satam Maharaj Seva Trust)**

The present application is filed by defendant No. 2/1 and 1/6 to condone the delay of 26 days in filing written statement.

2] Plaintiff has filed say on the reverse of the application (Exh.127) and prayed to reject the application.
