



ORDER BELOW EXH. 31

Read the application and say thereon. Heard the learned counsels for the parties at considerable length.

2. The learned counsel for the plaintiff submitted that the plaintiff has filed evidence affidavit and documents as per list of documents at Exh. 30. The said documents are relevant to the case of the plaintiff. Hence, submitted for exhibiting the said documents.

3. On the contrary, learned counsel for defendants submitted that except documents at Sr.N. 30/6, other documents are public documents. Considering age of witness he is incompetent to depose about Exh. 30/6. Hence, he objected to exhibit those documents below Sr. No. 30/6.

4. Perused the record. Document No. 1 to 5 and 7 to 9 filed alongwith list of documents (Exh. 30) are certified copies of public documents. Therefore, they are admissible in evidence and can be read in evidence. Hence, those documents are to be exhibited. Other documents are not admitted by the other side and they need to be proved by the plaintiff as per evidence act. Considering documents Exh. 30/6 are original '*Dhara Pavati*' on record, therefore, for identification purpose only those documents are to be exhibited on record.
