This is an application filed by the the plaintiff under Order I Rule 10 of Code of Civil Procedure. It is the contention of plaintiff that, defendants sold out the suit property to proposed defendants. They are necessary parties to decide the suit. Hence the plaintiff prayed that to allow this application.

2. By filing say the proposed defendant raised strong objection and prayed to rejection of the application.

5. Perused the record. This is suit for partition, declaration and injunction. It is the contention of plaintiff that the defendants have sold suit property to proposed defendant No.22 to 44. Therefore, in order to avoid multiplicity of the proceeding it

is necessary to allow the application. Hence, I pass the following order :

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The plaintiff is directed to add the names of proposed defendants No.22 to 44 as defendants and carry out the amendment in plaint.
