Vijay Titirmare Vs. State

Order Below Exh. 01.

(Passed On 09th June, 2026)

This is an application for releasing motorcycle Shine 125 Drum, Reg. No. Mh.36/AK/3042 which is seized in Cr. No.145/2026 of offence punishable under section 12 A of Prevention of Gambling Act. It is contention of the petitioner that he has not committed any offence as alleged. He is ready to abide the terms and conditions imposed by the court.

2. APP and IO filed say and raised an objection that the present motorcycle was seized in Cr. No.145/2026 for the commission of the offence punishable under section 12A of Prevention of Gambling Act. If it is released on Supurtnama he will used again in the same nature of offence in future and he will changed the nature of the property. Hence, prayed for rejection of application.

3. Heard, Shri. Ramteke learned counsel for the petitioner and Smt. Raut learned APP. Perused documents it seems that petitioner is the owner of motorcycle Shine 125 Drum, Reg. No. Mh.36/AK/3042. In this circumstances, if the said motorcycle is not released on Supurtnama then there is possibility to damage the same, on the contrary no prejudice would be caused to the state. Hence, I am of the view that petitioner is entitled for interim custody. Hence, I passed following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is hereby allowed.
- 2) The interim custody of motorcycle **Shine 125 Drum, Reg. No. Mh.36/AK/3042**, seized Cr. No. 145/2026 in PSO, Kardi be handed over to the petitioner on executing indemnity bond of Rs.70,000/- (Seventy thousand only) before in the court.
- 3) Applicant shall undertake that he shall not sale or transfer above said motorcycle, shall not change the colour, size or every feature of the motorcycle, without due permission of the court.
- 4) The applicant shall maintain and preserved the said motorcycle in all respect.
- 5) The applicant shall produced the photograph of the motorcycle on his own costs before the investigation officer.
- 6) The applicant shall produced the above said motorcycle as and when required by the IO and when directed by the court.
- 7) Applicant shall not used said motorcycle in same nature of offence in future failing which indemnity bond will be forfeited to government.
- 8) Applicant shall not misused the bond in any manner.
