ORDER BELOW EXH. 18

This is an application filed by the applicant/accused Namely **Nikhil Prabhakar Oge** permission to renew his Passport.

2] The applicant/accused submitted that, one criminal case is registered u/s. 325, 323, 503, 504, 509 r/w 34 of I.P.C.. The applicant is released on bail in the said crime. The case is pending for evidence. Charge has already been framed against the accused. Since, there is no reason for him being absconded, he may be granted permission to renew his passport since is old passport bearing No. M0349601, which has expired on 21/07/2024. Hence, the applicant/accused is praying for permission to renew his passport.

3] It is submitted that, the trial may take its own time. It is submitted that, accused is unable to renew the passport due to pendency of this case. The accused has submitted that, his passport has expired on 21/07/2024. For now, he requires no objection of the Court to renew the passport. He is ready to abide by the conditions imposed by the Court. On all these grounds, it is submitted to grant permission to renew passport.

4] Ld. A.P.P. their filed say and stated that the matter is part heard and considering this fact, necessary order may be

passed in this application. I have gone through the submission made by the learned advocate for the accused and say of learned APP for the State. The trial may take its time. Taking into consideration the contents of the application, affidavit and case papers prima-facie it appears that, the accused is resident of Koparigaon, Satynarayan Mandir, Virar East, Tal. Vasai, Dist. Palghar. Refusal to grant permission would affect fundamental right of the accused to travel in abroad. Thus, it is just and proper to grant the permission to renew the passport to the accused. Necessary conditions regarding prior permission before going to abroad and regarding representation and conducting the case without seeking adjournment in absence of the applicant/accused, have to be imposed. Hence, I pass the following order:-

:- O R D E R :-

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] The accused **Namely Nikhil Prabhakar Oge** is granted permission to renew his Passport for the period of ten (10) years, subject to provisions of Passport Act and Rules made thereunder.
- 3] The accused shall not leave India without prior of this Court. He shall file an undertaking in this regard.
