1. Appellant-original accused and his learned advocate is present. According to the appellant, his defence is not properly appreciated by the learned Trial Court. It is submitted that there was political rivalry between the family of appellant and the victim. It is submitted that they have hope of success.

2. Appellant has statutory right to prefer appeal against the order of conviction. It seems that amount of fine of Rs.5,000/- as awarded has already been deposited. Appellant is sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for one year for the offence punishable u/s. 354 of IPC. Appellant is resident of Dinodha (Madni), Tah. & Dist. Wardha itself. There are no chances of absconding. It is submitted that the appellant was on bail during the trial.

3. Considering the submissions and the facts order of execution of sentence of imprisonment needs to be suspended until further order. Hence, the order :

Order

1) Appellant be released on PR and SB of Rs.15,000/- till further order.

- 2) Order of execution of sentence of imprisonment in RCC No.23/2023 dated 10.01.2023 by learned J.M.F.C. (Court No.2), Wardha is suspended till further order.
- 3) Issue notice to the respondent as to why this order should not be confirmed. .
