

C.B.A. No. 287/2026
Muskan @ Shabnam Adil Ahmad Vs. State
Order Below Exh.01

Applicant/accused Muskan @ Shabnam Adil Ahmad has filed application for regular bail under section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in crime No. 496/2026 registered at Sawangi (Meghe) Police Station for the offence punishable under Sections 143(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 3, 4, 5 and 7 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956. Perused the application and say of the prosecution. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant and Ld. APP.

2] From the perusal of record, it appears that on receipt of secrete information, police conducted raid at Krushnai Court Building in a flat at Sawangi (Meghe). According to the prosecution, applicant/accused No.1 Muskan @ Shabnam forced the victim to engage in prostitution by luring her with money for her own financial benefits and accused No.2 Raju @ Nilesh Pradiprao Aadewar was found in the act of prostitution by a women.

3] Application is opposed on the ground that if the applicant released on bail, he may commit similar offences and pressurize witnesses.

4] It further appears that after rejection of the anticipatory bail, applicant surrender before police on 15/07/2026 and remanded to judicial custody on 16/07/2026. Nothing incriminating appears to be recovered from the applicant. Investigation as to the applicant appears to be completed. No other criminal antecedent of the applicant is appearing on the record. Under the circumstances, further detention of the applicant is not required for the purpose of investigation. Hence, applicant can be released on bail subject to conditions. In the result, following order.

ORDER

1. Application is hereby allowed.
2. Applicant/accused Muskan @ Shabnam Adil Ahmad shall be released on bail in crime No. 496/2026 registered at Sawangi (Meghe) Police Station on his executing Personal Bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and a surety in the like sum.
3. The applicant/accused shall not threaten, pressurize or dissuade the victim and any other prosecution witnesses directly or indirectly, and shall not tamper evidence.
4. Bail before the Ld. Committal Court.
5. Hamdast allowed.
