

Common Order below Exh.01
In RCA No.65/2020 and RCA No.66/2020.

1. The present appeals are pending before this Court since 2020. Both the parties time and again orally admitted before this Court that some of the legal heirs are not made parties to the suit.
2. Today, Advocate V. T. Gurnule for the appellants and the respondent Mr. Sanjay Deshkar personally present before the Court. I have asked the names of the parties to both of them, but none of them disclosed names of the legal heirs who are not made party to the litigation.
3. Both the appeals are born out of the decree in the partition suit, the partition suit is having peculiar nature and all the parties are plaintiffs in the suit. Each and every party in the suit are duty bound to disclose the names of the legal heirs who are entitled to inherit the suit property. Though for number of times, I have requested Advocate V. T. Gurnule and Shri. Sanjay Deshkar to disclose the names, they have not disclosed the same. As the proceedings are relating to the partition and the respondent Mr. Sanjay Deshkar is a family member as well as appellants are also family members, all appellants and respondents are directed to submit the family tree on affidavits by disclosing names of all the legal heirs of common ancestor within seven days from the date of this order. The original copy of this order be kept in RCA No.65/2020 and the photocopy be kept in RCA No.66/2020.
