ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(Passed on 14th March, 2026)

This is claim petition under Motor Vehicles Act. The claimant and their advocate and respondent (Insurance Company) and their advocate, non-applicant no.4 and 5 and their advocate are present before National Lok-Adalat held on 13.03.2026. The claimant is real mother of the deceased. The non-applicant no.4 is the widow of the deceased, whereas non-applicant no.5 is the son of the deceased.

As per pursis below Exh.27 and 28, the matter is amicably settled between the claimant and non-applicant no.4 and 5 and non-applicant no.3 Insurance Company being amount of Rs.21,00,000/- towards full and final settlement of the death accident petition within two months of this order.

It is agreed between non-applicant no.4 and 5 and claimant to accept the amount in equally proportionate. So, considering the matter is settled as per pursis below Exh.27 and 28. The Rs.7,00,000/- be paid to the claimant and Rs.14,00,000/- distributed to the non-applicant no.4 and 5, out of 14,00,000/-, Rs.6,00,000/- be deposited in the Fixed Deposit in Nationalize Bank of the choice of non-applicant no.4 in the name of non-applicant no.5, till he attains age of majority. The non-applicant no.4 is entitled for receiving interest amount of said Fixed Deposit for welfare of the non-applicant no.5.

The non-applicant no.4 will be entitled to apply for withdrawal of partial amount of Rs.6,00,000/- in future for the parties to welfare and

educational needs of non-applicant no.5. Even prior, he attains the age of majority. However, such withdrawal will be solely based upon needs and circumstances at relevant time.

Since the matter is settled in the National Lok-Adalat, the award be prepared and passed. As the matter is settled before National Lok-Adalat, therefore as per provisions of Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987, the claimant is not liable to make the payment of Court Fee. The claimant is entitled for refund of entire Court Fee, if deposited earlier. Award be prepared accordingly.
