

**ORDER BELOW EXH - 27**

1] This is an application filed by appellant No. 1C seeking permission to bring on record the legal representatives of deceased appellant No. 1A, namely Ravindra Bhagvantrao Kadu, who expired on 18/02/2022.

2] It is submitted that appellant No. 1A left behind the following legal heirs:

- Minal d/o Ravindra Kadu, aged about 26 years, resident of Hinganghat Fail, Ward No. 6, Pulgaon, Tah. Deoli, Dist. Wardha.
- Rohit s/o Ravindra Kadu, aged about 24 years, resident of Hinganghat Fail, Ward No. 6, Pulgaon, Tah. Deoli, Dist. Wardha.

3] Order XXII Rule 3 CPC provides that upon the death of a party, the legal representatives must be brought on record to represent the estate of the deceased. Failure to do so may result in abatement of proceedings.

4] In the present case, the death of appellant No. 1A has been duly reported, and the names of his legal heirs have been furnished. Their impleadment is necessary to ensure that the appeal is adjudicated on merits and that the rights of the estate of the deceased appellant are duly protected.

5] There is no objection raised regarding the status of the

proposed legal representatives, and the application appears to be bona fide.

6] The application deserves to be allowed. The legal representatives of deceased appellant No. 1A are required to be substituted in his place to avoid abatement and to secure proper adjudication of the appeal.

**ORDER**

1. The application is **allowed**.
2. The legal representatives of deceased appellant No. 1A, namely Minal d/o Ravindra Kadu and Rohit s/o Ravindra Kadu, are hereby brought on record in place of deceased appellant No. 1A.
3. Necessary amendment in the cause title be carried out accordingly.
