

ORDER BELOW EXH - 28

1] This is an application filed by the appellants seeking permission to bring on record the legal representatives of deceased appellant No. 1B, **Vilas Kadu**, who expired on 14/10/2024.

2] It is submitted that appellant No. 1B left behind his widow:

- **Smt. Lalita w/o Vilas Kadu**, aged about 38 years, occupation: household, resident of Hinganghat Fail, Ward No. 6, Pulgaon, Tah. Deoli, Dist. Wardha.

3] The counsel for appellants has reported the death of appellant No. 1B and prayed that his legal representative be substituted in his place to represent his estate in the pending appeal.

4] Order XXII Rule 3 CPC provides that upon the death of a party, the legal representatives must be brought on record to avoid abatement of proceedings. The death of appellant No. 1B has been duly reported, and the name of his legal heir has been furnished.

5] The impleadment of the legal representative is necessary to ensure proper adjudication of the appeal on merits. No objection has been raised regarding the status of the proposed legal representative, and the application

appears to be bona fide.

6] The application deserves to be allowed. The legal representative of deceased appellant No. 1B shall be substituted in his place to safeguard the rights of his estate and to avoid abatement.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The legal representative of deceased appellant No. 1B, namely Smt. Lalita w/o Vilas Kadu, is hereby brought on record in place of deceased appellant No. 1B.
3. Necessary amendment in the cause title be carried out accordingly.
