

COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH. 140 to 144

Perused the record. It appears that matter is private complaint filed under section 499 & 500 R/w. section 34 of the I.P.C. It is a summary case. After issuance of the process inspite of service of summons the accused Nos. 2 to 6 and 8 failed to appear before this Court. Hence, bailable warrants were issued against them. Accordingly, accused Nos. 2 to 6 and 8 being publication house their acting persona are present before this Court. As bailable warrants were issued against them and they are being present before this Court, their bailable warrants are justified to be cancelled. The accused persons being reputed publication house of the society and still failed to appear in accordance of the summons of the Court, reflects their casual approach towards the proceeding which cannot be ignored. Hence, this Court is of the opinion that, bailable warrants of the accused persons are justified to be cancelled as per the penalty of the order. Further, the accused No. 2 prayed for bail considering the nature of the matter, his bail application is considered in view of final order. Hence, following order -

ORDER

- 1) The bailable warrants of accused Nos. 2 to 6 & 8 are cancelled subject to penalty of Rs. 1,000/- each.

- 2) Accused No. 2 is released on P.B. of Rs. 15,000 and cash surety of Rs. 5,000/-.
- 3) As all the accused persons and their Ld. counsels are present before the Court, this order is considered to be noted by all of them.
- 4) It strictly directed to the complainant to proceed with the matter immediately.
