**Order below Supratnama Application Exh. 1**

(Dt. 17/03/2026)

The present application has been filed for seeking the release of gold ornaments i.e. gold fancy chain of 6.990 grams (poth), gold locket of 3.980 grams, gold beads (mani) of 900 milligrams and a silver glass of 50 grams in connection with Crime no. 1617/2026 for the offence punishable U/s. 305(a), 331(3), 331(4) of the B.N.S. registered with Police Station, Wardha (C.).

2. Say filed by I.O. and A.P.P. The Ld. A.P.P. and I.O. have not objected to release the abovesaid gold in favour of the applicant.

3. Heard Shri. Lokhande, Ld. counsel for the applicant and Ld. A.P.P. Perused documents.

4. The applicants submitted that, the husband of applicant No. 1 has lodged F.I.R. when the abovesaid gold and silver ornaments were stolen by the unknown accused from thier house. On perusal of say of I.O. it reveals that, the police have seized 10.020 gram gold bar (Lagadi) from the accused in the said crime. The applicants have filed copy of F.I.R., verified copy

of bills of gold ornaments and verified copy of their Adhar cards as an identity proof. The applicants submitted that, they are the owners of seized gold. As I have already mentioned that, I.O. has not objected to release the seized gold in favour of the applicants. No any other person claimed the abovesaid gold.

5. As nobody has claimed the abovesaid seized 10.020 gram gold bar (Lagadi) till today, *prima-facie* it appears that, the applicants are entitled for interim possession of the same. Further, the applicants have filed some bills regarding purchase of gold are of the year 2006 and the bond is to be taken at present in 2026. The gold rates have already fluctuated a long and it reached upto Rs. 15,000/- per gram. In view of it, taking bond of the gold prayed to be released as per old rates will make the surety inadequate in reference to the present indemnity bond. Thus, the bond amount is determined in view of this fact. Therefore, this Court think it is proper to release the said gold on supratnama in favour of the applicants, imposing certain conditions. Hence, following order -

### ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The applicants will furnish to the investigating officer two self attested colored photographs of the seized gold for the purpose of the identification. The investigating officer shall facilitate the photographs.
- 3) The applicants will produce the abovesaid gold as and when directed by the Court.

- 4) The applicants will not alienate the abovesaid gold without prior permission of the Court.
- 5) The applicants will execute a Supurtnama bond at concern police station binding themselves abide by the above conditions No. 3 & 4 and in default to forfeit Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) to the Government.
- 6) After execution of the Supurtnama bond and furnishing colored photographs by the applicants, the investigating officer shall handover the custody of seized 10.020 gram gold bar (Lagadi) to the applicants.
- 7) This proceeding be tagged with the case papers as and when final report is received in the same crime.
- 8) Issue copy of this order to the investigating officer for its compliance.
