**APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 503 OF B. N. S. S. FOR
RELEASING THE 2 BIG SILVER BISCUIT, 7 SMALL
SILVER BISCUIT, 4 SMALL SAMPLE PIECES OF SILVER
TOTTAL WEIGHT 2 Kg. 348 Grams, 170 MILIGRAM
SILVER ON SUPRATNAMA TO THE APPLICANT.**

The applicant named above most humbly and respectfully
begs to submit as under.

1) That the applicant is residential of above mentioned
address and he is owner of Shalimar Computerised Gold Testing



and Refinery Center Chandrapur at near Dastagir Darga, Sarafa Line, Bazar Ward, Chandrapur. And his business is taking the gold and silver from customer and other jewellers and testing the quality of Gold and Silver as well as he taking the orders of refinery of Gold and Silver also. In the month of February he collect the Silver from

- (1) New Uttam Jewellers, Sarafa Line Chandrapur impure silver 380 Grams dated 09-02-2026.
- (2) Mohak Jewellers Sarafa Line Chandrapur 977.00 Grams impure silver dated 08-02-2026.
- (3) Manibhai Jewellers Sarafa Line Chandrapur impured silver weight 418.00 Grams dated 07-02-2026.
- (4) Nutan Swarn Kala Kendra impured silver weight 384.00 Grams dated 06-02-2026
- (5) Anand Jewellers Chamorshi, impured silver weight 450.00 Grams dated 07-02-2026.

Total 2609.00 Grams from above mentioned jewellers and the applicants have the bills of above jewellers shop that he has been collected 2609.00 Grams impured silver from 06-02-2026 to 09-02-2026. He tested all the silver and he have the receipt of Shalimar testing centre 2609 Grams of impured silver and applicant send that silver to the DSR silver refinery, Nagpur for purification because in Chandrapur there is not silver refinery. Therefore applicant sent silver for purification to the Nagpur refinery through his agent/worker namely Ratan Pralhadrai Puraswani and after completion of purification of silver Ratan Puraswani came to the Chandrapur railway station railway police stopped to applicants agent /worker Ratan Puraswani and seized the black blue colour cotton bag in that total 2 Kg 348 grams 170 miligram pured silver had been kept i.e., 2 big silver biscuits, 7 small silver biscuits and 4 sample pieces of silver was in the black and blue bag. That bag seized by G. R. P. Under Section 124 of Maharashtra Police Act under N. C. No. 01/2026 on the basis of without evidence only on the doubt and on 10-



02-2026 the G. R. P. Wardha prepared the Panchanama described the pured silver as

- 1) One big silver biscuit weight 390 Grams.
- 2) One big silver biscuit weight 386 Grams.
- 3) First small silver biscuit weight 197.300 Grams.
- 4) Second small silver biscuits weight 170.00 Grams.
- 5) Third small Silver Biscuit weight 250.00 Grams.
- 6) Fourth small silver biscuit weight 250.00 Gram.
- 7) Fifth small silver biscuit weight 233.00 Grams.
- 8) Sixth small silver biscuits weight 253.900 Grams.
- 9) Seventh small silver biscuit 210.00 Grams.

and four pieces of sample of silver weight 07.97 Grams total of purified silver was 2 Kg 348 grams 170 miligrams (as per 2,70,000/- Rs. Kg silver) total price was 6,34,000/- and front of that biscuit written as DS and fine silver 999.



2) The prosecution story is that the Ratan Puraswani not having any bills and he did not given any evidence he possess the silver on his doubt only the P. S. O. G. R. P. Wardha lodge the N. C. report 01/2026 under Section 124 of Maharashtra Police Act.

3) That, the Ratan Pralhadrai Puraswani aged 57 years R/o. Chandrapur is applicants worker/agent and he always go to out of station and Nagpur for applicants work. Applicant pay money and commissions to Ratan Puraswani. On the 10-02-2026 applicant gave the black and blue colour cotton bag which contains 2609.00 Grams impured silver which collected from other jewellers for purification. The Ratan Pralhadrai Puraswani at the morning on dt. 10-02-2026 when he was going to the Nagpur in DSR silver refinery for the work of purification of impured silver.

Thereafter on 10-02-2026 Ratan Pralhadrao Puraswani at Morning 6.30 p.m.to sit on the G. T. Express with black and blue cotton bag for going to the Nagpur and the train reached at

the Nagpur Railway station on 12.00 noon on the same day and thenafter he gone to the D. S. R. Refinery at Itwai Nagpur and give 2609 Kilogram impure silver for the purification and the D. S. R. refinery purified the silver and returned 2 Kg 348 grams 170 Miligram purified silver in to the form of –

- (1) One big silver biscuit weight 390 Grams.
- (2) One big silver biscuit weight 386 Grams.
- (3) First small silver biscuit weight 197.300 Grams.
- (4) Second small silver biscuit weight 170.00 Grams.
- (5) Third small silver biscuit weight 250.00 Grams.
- (6) Fourth small silver biscuit weight 250.00 Grams.
- (7) Fifth small silver biscuit weight 233.00 Grams.
- (8) Sixth small silver biscuit weight 253.900 Grams.
- (9) Seventh small silver biscuit weight 210.00 Grams.

and four pieces of sample of silver its weight 07.97 Grams
total of purified silver was 2 Kg 348 Grams 170 Miligram of

(Rs. 2,70,000/- Per Kg) Rupees. 6,34,000/- and wastage material was 261.00 Grams which left in the DSR refinery and D. S. R. silver refinery of Itwari Nagpur give bills on dated 10-02-2026 in the name of applicant Vijay Salunkhe Chandrapur and given the bill of impured silver was 2609 Grams weight, purity, (touch) was 90 % and fine purified silver was 2348 Grams and marked D. S. A. Fine silver 999 on 2 big silver biscuit, 7 small silver biscuits and 4 small sample pieces of silver and same quantity seized letter by G. R. P. Wardha on dt. 10-02-2026 within the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.

4) That, after the finishing work of purification of silver Ratan Pralhadrai Puraswani came to the Nagpur Railway Station at 3.00 P. M. And to sit on the railway and reached at Chandrapur at 6.30 P.M. and he was going to the Shalimar silver testing shop for delivery of that black and blue bag which containing the 2 big and 7 small silver biscuits and 4 sample pieces of silver total weight 2 Kg 348 grams and 170 Miligrams weight there some police was standing there in civil dress and

asked Ratan Puraswani what is in the bag then he feel fear by the sound of police who is standing in the civil dress and then after he said nothing but the police checked his black and blue colour cotton bag and they found 2348 Grams 170 Miligram purified silver in his black and blue bag letter on prepared seizer panchanama on dated 10-02-2026 at 21.59 to 22.35 p.m. and registered the N. C. R. No. 01/2026 under Section 124 of Maharashtra Police Act on dated 11-02-2026 taking in to the police station diary at 4.30 p.m.

5. When the applicant get the information about that his 2 Kg, 348 Grams, 170 Miligrams purified silver has been seized by the G. R. P. Wardha. Therefore the applicant filed the Suprutnama before this Hon'ble Court because the applicant had the constructive possession of 2 Kg 438 Grams and 170 Miligrams purified silver. The applicant has been filed the document with application 1) bill of this jewellers 2) applicants receipt of testing of accumulation of impured silver 3) the D. S. R. silver refinery bills 4) licence of his shop 5) Aadhar card of

applicant 6) Pan card of applicant 7) Aadhar Card of Ratan Puraswani annexed with this application and the applicant will annex other document with the permission of court on the requisition.

7) If the Hon'ble Court not released that 2 Kg 348 Grams 170 Miligrams purified silver in favour of applicant then the jewellers and applicant getting heavy leave lossess. And the G. R. P. Wardha police station have not suitable place to keep the proper custody of that 2 Kg 348 Gram 170 Miligrams purified silver biscuits and sample pieces of silver would be tarnishing its value and quality its cause heavy losses to the applicant and jewellers. Therefore it needs to be releasing the 2 Kg 348 Grams 170 Miligram purified silver biscuits and 4 pieces of silver sample in favour of applicant.

9. That the applicant further submit that he will abide by each and every condition imposed by Hon'ble Court for the release of above 2 Kg. 348 Grams 170 Miligram purified silver i.e., two big biscuit and 7 small biscuits and four sample pieces

of silver on Suprutnama in a favour of the applicant. The applicant further undertakes that he will not sell, mortgage, gift, disposed of above silver purified silver biscuits and pieces by any means whatsoever to anybody else during the pendency of present trial. He further undertakes to furnish the indemnity bond required for satisfaction of this Hon'ble Court.

Hence this application.

Prayer :- It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to passed the order of releasing -

- 1) One big silver biscuit weight 390 Grams.
- 2) One big silver biscuit weight 386 Grams.
- 3) First small silver biscuit weight 197.300 Grams.
- 4) Second small silver biscuits weight 170.00 Grams.
- 5) Third small Silver Biscuit weight 250.00 Grams.
- 6) Fourth small silver biscuit weight 250.00 Gram.
- 7) Fifth small silver biscuit weight 233.00 Grams.

8) Sixth small silver biscuits weight 253.900 Grams.


