Fresh suit is received through e-portal. It be checked and registered.

Heard. Record perused.

Plaintiff has filed the present suit for recovery of Rs.13,92,074/- for sale of microscope machine to the defendant through invoice dated 14.01.2023, which falls within the definition of Commercial Dispute as defined u/s 2 (1) (c) of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015.

Let summons for settlement of issues be issued against defendant on filing of PF, Speed Post, approved courier as well as through electronic mode, on filing of an affidavit as per Rule 12 of the Delhi Courts Service of Processes by Courier, Fax and Electronic Mail Service (Civil Proceedings) Rules, 2010 for next date of hearing. Steps be taken within a week.

It be noted on the summons that the defendant is required to file written statement within 30 days of the service of summons and further extension of time in filing the written statement can only be granted after sufficient reasons are shown and that too subject to payment of cost as may be considered appropriate by the Court. However, in any case, time would not be extended beyond a period of 120 days.

A copy of this order be sent alongwith the summons also to the defendant as per rules.
