**ORDER BELOW EXH NO. 01**  
**(Passed on 18/03/2026)**

This is an application filed by the applicant under Section 503 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for releasing cash amount of Rs.46,000/- on supratnama.

2] The applicant contended that he is owner of seized cash amount of Rs.46,000/-. Police Station Karanja Gha. has seized the

aforesaid cash amount in crime No.31/2026 from accused in offence p/u/s 303(2) of BNS 2023. Applicant further contended that he required seized amount and he is ready to produced given amount before court whenever called by court. As well as, he is ready to furnished bond as per the order of court. Hence, this application.

3] The applicant in support of this application has filed some documents such as copy of Aadhar card of applicant and copy of F.I.R.

4] After receipt of this application, this court had called say of Ld. APP and Police Station Karanja Gha. Police Station Karanja Gha. has filed say and stated that they have seized amount of Rs.46,000/- from accused Abdul Wahid Abdul Hamid during investigation. They have also stated that it is concluded from their investigation that applicant is owner of seized amount of Rs.46,000/-. Hence, they have no objection to released amount of Rs.46,000/- to applicant.

5] Learned A.P.P. has also stated that I.O, has filed no objection to released amount to the applicant. Prosecution also has no objection to released that amount to applicant but subject to condition that applicant shall not tamper seized amount and produced that amount as and when required.

6] Perused the documents. It is reveals that, applicant is a complainant in crime no.31/2026. Total amount of Rs.46,000/- was stolen from his custody. Accordingly he had made report against accused. during investigation amount of Rs.46,000/- has seized by police from accused. It is also revealed from say of I.O. that seized amount belongs to applicant. In such circumstances it is seen that applicant is the owner of seized amount. Therefore, the amount which is seized by police can be released on supurtnama to the applicant. Thus, considering aforesaid reason, I pass following order.

**ORDER**

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] The seized cash amount of Rs.46,000/- shall be handed over to applicant until further order, on the execution of indemnity bond of Rs.46,000/- (Rs. Forty Six Thousand only).
- 3] The Investigating Officer is directed to take photographs and prepare panchanama.
- 4] The applicant shall undertake to produce the said cash amount as and when required by Investigating Officer, Police Station Karanja Gha. or after filing of charge-sheet, before the Court.
- 5] The applicant is directed to furnish the said indemnity bond before Investigating Officer, Police Station Karanja Gha.
- 6] The Investigating Officer is directed to attach the said panchanama, indemnity bond etc. with the charge-sheet.
- 7] Accordingly, application is disposed of on aforesaid terms.
