

**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT - 20**

1. The plaintiff has moved this application under Order VI Rule 17 of Code of Civil Procedure, for amendment of plaint.

2. Heard Learned Adv. Smt. K. S. Nikhade for the Plaintiff Heard Adv. V. T. Deshpande for the defendant. The following points arise for determination for which I have given my findings for the reasons stated thereafter :

**REASONS**

3. The plaintiff has submitted that due to typing mistake and oversight, there is mistake in the plaint about the name in Genology therefore the plaintiff desires to amendment the plaint. The defendant has strongly opposed the application. The submitted that the plaintiff has not given any reason for amendment. He prayed for dismissal for the application.

4. On perusal of record and applicant it appears that the proposed the amendment is minute and due the typing mistake and oversight. Further it appears that the proposed amendment is necessary for determining the real question in controversy

between the parties. It does not appear that the proposed amendment will change the nature of case. Moreover to avoid the multiplicity of litigations, the proposed amendment is necessary.

5. In present suit, the trial yet not commenced. The suit has been filed on dated 31.12.2018. After filing written statement of defendants the suit is posted for issues. The plaintiff has various opportunities to amend the plaint at the earliest. However, the other party can be compensated for the same.

**As to Point No. 2:**

6. As stated above, the plaintiff are entitled to carry out the proposed amendment. Therefore, this application is entitled to be allowed. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:

**ORDER**

1. The application Exh. 20 is allowed.
2. The plaintiff is permitted to carry out the amendment within limitation period, subject to condition that she shall pay Rs. 200/- to the defendant.
