

Perused application and heard Ld. Advocate for plaintiffs. It is submitted by Ld. Advocate for plaintiffs that suit property is ancestral property which was transferred in the name of defendant. Now defendant is trying to alienate Survey no. 960 and executed agreement to sale of that property. Plaintiffs have apprehension that she will sell out ~~the~~ suit property and it ~~will~~ cause hardship to plaintiffs. Because they also have right in suit property.

Plaintiffs have file T/12 extract of survey no 960 which is in the name of defendant. It is not a ~~profe~~ proof of ownership. However, alienation of suit property on this basis may be possible. Thus, to avoid multiplicity of proceeding I pass following order.

order

- 1) Defendant is temporarily restrain from alienating suit property to third person. till next date.
- 2) Issue notices to defendant as to why order of T.I shall not be granted against her.
- 3) EB and SB is allowed, if required.
- 4) Plaintiff is directed to comply provision of O.39 Rule 3 of CPC.
