

Order below Exh.07.

The present application filed by the learned counsel for D.H. for restoration of Arbitration Proceeding.

2. It is submitted that Court has passed order below Exh.1 and the present arbitration proceeding came to be disposed off for want of prosecution. It is submitted that due to BAR Counsel Election, he could appear before Court and could not take step in the matter. The D.H. has strong case on merit. If matter is not restored, D.H. will suffer irreparable loss. Hence, prayed to recall the order and restore the arbitration proceeding to their original stage.

Today, I have passed an order below Exh.1 as no steps have been taken into the matter by D.H., and D.H. failed to appear before the Court I have therefore ordered the matter stands dismissed for want of prosecution. Thereafter, learned counsel for D.H. appeared and filed the present application. The reason mentioned by the learned counsel for D.H. is bonafide and hence, order passed below Exh.1 needs to be recalled. Hence, following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed and the dismissed in default order passed below Exh.1 on today against D.H. is hereby set aside subject to costs of Rs.500/- to be paid to DLSA, Washim.
- 2) After payment of costs, the Arbitration Proceeding be restored at its original stage.
- 3) Both parties and their respective advocates to take note.
