ORDER BELOW EXH.22

Non applicant No.1 has filed present application with the prayer that, 'no written statement' order passed against him be set-aside & thereby, he be permitted to file his written statement. Perused the application, say filed by the applicant thereon.

2. It is submitted that respondent failed to file reply in time for want of important documents therefore, delay is caused in filing reply and no WS order has been passed. Hence, permission be granted to file WS on record by way of setting aside no ws order.

3. Application is opposed by the applicants by filing say overleaf. It is submitted that non applicant no.1 filed their VP on 09.08.2024 and there is almost 11 months delay. Hence, prayed to reject the application. If application is allowed, then heavy cost of Rs.5,000/- impose on non applicant no.1 in the interest of justice.

4. Perused application and say. Heard both sides. Upon hearing both sides I hold that it would be just and proper to decide the matter finally on merits. Furthermore, no prejudice would occasion to the applicants, if the application is allowed. At the same time it is necessary to impose costs for causing delay in the matter. In the result, following order is passed:

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) No WS order passed against the non applicant is hereby set aside.

3) Non applicant No.1 is permitted to file WS on record subject to payment of Rs.500/- to be paid to the applicants.
