

ORDER BELOW EXH.30.

Applicant has filed this application for condonation of delay for bringing the legal heirs on record of deceased Pramod Rangbhal and for setting aside the abatement order.

2. Applicant submitted that he has received the notice on or near about 25/09/2023 informing that the father of the applicant has filed this appeal before this Court. After receiving the said letter from advocate of applicant, his mother and his minor brother came to know about some litigation is pending. Accordingly applicant approached to the advocate and given the information regarding the legal heirs of deceased Pramod Rangbhal. After visiting the office of advocate appellant was asked about the legal heirs. Other legal heirs were not willing to make application. Therefore, the applicant is alone filed this application. He submitted that after receiving the information from the advocate, immediately he has filed this application and there is delay of 170 days. The said delay is not deliberate and intentional. Therefore, prayed that delay may kindly be condoned. If it is not condoned then they will be suffer irreparable loss. On the contrary no loss will be caused to other side. Therefore, prayed to grant the application.

3. Respondent has not filed say. Hence, the application is proceeded without say.

4. Heard the advocate of applicant.

5. I have gone through the application and submissions of the party then it is gathered that these applicants have no knowledge regarding pending of the appeal. After receiving the notice from the advocate, applicant came to know about this appeal. Then immediately he filed this application. Considering the said reason, I come to the conclusion that applicant has given the satisfactory reason to condoned the delay. If the application is allowed no prejudice will cause to the other side. On the contrary if it is not allowed irreparable loss will be cause to the applicant. In the interest of justice application can be condoned. Hence following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is hereby allowed.
- 2) Delay to take legal representatives on record is hereby condoned.
- 3) Applicant is directed to carry out the necessary amendment by bringing the legal heirs on record immediately.
