**Sessions Case No.22/2026
State v. Prakash Pawar
MHWS010002692026**

Order below Exh.03.

The applicant/accused Prakash Shriram Pawar has filed this application for grant of regular bail under section 483 of BNSS, 2023 in Crime no.640/2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 109(1) of BNS 2023 registered with Police Station Malegaon, Tq.Malegaon, Dist. Washim.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicant/accused and learned APP for the State. Perused the case diary.

3. Learned Deputy Chief, Legal Aid Defence Counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that applicant/accused is arrested on 27/12/2025 in aforesaid crime. Informant lodged report against the applicant/accused that on 25/12/2025 at about 10.00 am, she was sitting with her husband's brother's wife (sister in law) and cracking the marking nuts. Informant's husband told her to serve her meal upon which informant told him to take your own. On that count, dispute arose and her husband assaulted her by axe on her head. Therefore, informant lodged report.

4. It is submitted that the informant lodged false report against the applicant/accused. The accused has not assaulted informant. On the contrary, the brother, wife of brother, mother and father assaulted the applicant/accused. The investigation is over and charge sheet is filed in the Court. Applicant/accused is in jail for last 2 and half months. Applicant is ready to abide by all terms and

conditions. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

5. The learned APP and investigating officer has filed say and objected the application on the ground that offence is serious in nature. The applicant/accused is the husband of informant. If applicant/accused is released on bail, he may against commit such type of offence again. He may also pressurize the informant and witnesses. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

6. I have gone through the record. It appears that the statement of witnesses reveals that present applicant/accused has assaulted the informant Sitabai by means of axe on her head and caused grievous injury to her. The injury report also shows that informant sustained grievous injury on her head by sharp edge. It shows the prima facie involvement of the applicant/accused in present crime. The applicant/accused and victim are husband and wife. Hence, it is not proper to grant the bail application to applicant/accused at this stage. In the result, I pass following order.

ORDER

Application is hereby rejected.
