

**Cri.B.A.No.79/2026**  
**Nisha+1 v. State**  
**MHWS010002722026**

**Order below Exh.01.**

The applicant no.1 Nisha Sadanand Gaikwad and 2. Anusaya Dagadu Gaikwad have filed present application for grant of anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 apprehending their arrest in crime no.180/2026 for the offence punishable under Sections 132, 121(1), 351(1), 351(2), 352, 309(4), 3(5) of BNS 2023 registered with Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicants and learned APP for the State. Perused the case diary.

3. The learned advocate for the applicant/accused submitted that informant Amjadkhan Pathan lodged report alleging that he is working as a Peon at N.P. Washim since 1996. On 17/02/2026 at about 11 am when he went to recover nalpatti tax in Risod city, he called Anusaya Gaikwad (applicant no.2) and asked for Rs.5,400/- tax outstanding towards her. At that time, her son Sadanand Gaikwad came out of house and told informant that 'Why did you speak to my mother so rudely?' and he started quarreling with him. Sadanand also abused informant and slapped her. Both the applicants pushed informant and abused him and also threatened him to kill. Therefore, informant lodged complaint. It is submitted that applicants are innocent and they have no connected with crime. PSO, Risod has released the accused on bail to Sadanand Gaikwad. On the contrary, applicant no.1 Nisha filed complaint at police station against the informant and Nandkishor

Dakhore under section 351(1), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS 2023 and section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of the SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. It is submitted that nothing is to be recovered from the applicants. There is no direct evidence against the applicants. The applicants are ready to abide by any conditions imposed by the Court. They are ready to cooperate the investigating machinery. Hence, they prayed to allow the application.

4. Learned APP and investigating officer have opposed the bail application on the ground that the offence is serious one. The amount Rs.9,000/- yet to be seized. Informant belongs to Muslim community, if applicants are granted anticipatory bail, dispute could be arise between two communities. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

5. After going through the record it appears that the co-accused i.e. Sadanand Gaikwad is released on bail by lower Court. It also appears that both parties have lodged report against each other. The applicants are ready to abide by all the conditions imposed by the Court. Hence, considering these facts and circumstances, applicants deserve to grant bail application. In the result, I pass following order.

**ORDER**

1.	Application is allowed.
2.	In the event of arrest of the applicant/accused no.1 Nisha Sadanand Gaikwad and 2. Anusaya Dagadu Gaikwad in crime no.180/2026 for the offence punishable under Sections 132, 121(1), 351(1), 351(2), 352, 309(4), 3(5) of BNS 2023 registered with

	Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim, they be released on P.R. Bond of Rs.25,000/- each with one solvent surety in the like amount.
3.	Applicant/accused shall co-operate the Investigating Officer and shall attend the concerned police station as and when called by the I.O. by giving advance notices in writing.
4.	Applicant/accused shall not pressurize the complainant and the witnesses and shall not contact with the complainant in any manner.
5.	Issue intimation to concern police station.
6.	Hamdast allowed.
