This is an application preferred under Sec.482 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 for release of applicant on anticipatory bail in Crime No.0076/2026 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 311 & 352 of BNS 2023 registered with Ansing Police Station.

Brief facts are as follows -

2. On 03/03/2026 the accused did mobile call to informant and called him at Panipuri Stall. In the vehicle he went there. Accused hurled abuses to him and inflicted blow of iron Khanjar. Other 3 to 4 persons present with him assaulted informant. They snatched Rs.80,000/- and they ran away. Thereafter informant took medical treatment and on 04/03/2026 he lodged FIR on the basis of which present crime is registered. As the informant is having reasonable apprehension of his arrest in non bailable offence, therefore, he has preferred this application for anticipatory bail.

3. The prosecution as well as informant have opposed the bail application by filing written objection.

4. It is argued by Ld. Advocate Shri.Ingle that no such incident taken place. In fact, informant and his friend beaten accused. Therefore, he lodged NC on 03/03/2026. There was transaction of money lending between them. Informant was demanding interest amount and accused refused. Hence, false crime is registered. There is delay to lodge FIR. Hence, they are praying for his release on anticipatory bail.

5. Per contra, It is argued by Ld. APP Shri.Kaloo as well as PI that previous extortion crime is registered against applicant. He is habitual offender. In this crime Rs.80,000/- as well as weapon are yet to be seized. Custodial interrogation is necessary. Hence, they are praying for rejection of the application.

6. Having heard the following points arise.

REASONS

As to point no.1 :

7. FIR discloses specific role played by the accused. Rs.80,000/- are yet to be seized. So also weapon of offence are yet to be seized. Previous Crime No.546/2026 is pending against applicant for extortion. IO submitted that after registration of present crime on 13/03/2026 applicant has threatened the informant to take back FIR and threat was given on Instagram. NCR is registered to that effect. Thus, prima-facie it is case of threat to informant and witnesses. All these aspect shows that it is not fit case go release the accused on anticipatory bail. Hence, I answer point No.1 in the negative and pass the following order.

ORDER

Application is rejected.
