

**Sessions Case No.23/2026
State v. Santosh
MHWS010002992026**

Order below Exh.03.

The applicant Santosh Ramrao Khandare has filed present application for grant of regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in crime No.27/2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 103(1), 64(1) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered with Police Station Washim city, Tq. Dist. Washim.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicant and learned APP for the State. Perused the case diary.

3. The case of prosecution is that as per information received via letter from railway department to PSO Washim city that there is one lady lying in unconscious state near rest house situated in railway premises. Hence, complainant went to the spot of incident. There one lady found lying in partially naked condition. The blood was found over forehead of said woman. Hence, complainant lodged report against unknown person.

4. The learned advocate for the applicant submitted that the police arrested the applicant despite there being no evidence against him. The witnesses are hearsay witnesses. There is no eye witnesses to the incident. The applicant is the person who does labour work out of district. He was arrested on the suspicion only. The applicant is behind bars since 09/01/2026. The applicant is ready to co-operate the investigating officer. He is only bread winner of his family. Hence,

prayed to allow the application.

5. The learned APP and Investigating Officer have filed say vide Exh.05 and objected the application on the ground that if applicant/ accused is released on bail, he may pressurize prosecution witnesses. The accused may commit such type of offence again. CA report is yet to be received in this matter. The offence is serious one and against the woman. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

6. After going through the record it appears that statement of one contractor, Mujjamil Khan Jamil Khan recorded on 13/01/2026. He disclosed the name of applicant. He specifically stated that the applicant along with one Nagesh Narkhede worked at his site at Mantri Park, Washim till 06 pm on 08/01/2026. The statement of Nagesh Narkhede also shows that he along with applicant went to the site of contractor, Mujjamil Khan Jamil Khan, Mantri Park, Washim. It shows prima facie involvement of this applicant in this matter. So it is not proper to grant bail application to this accused. Hence, following order.

ORDER

Application stands rejected.
