

Cri.B.A.No.93/2026
Sachin v. State

The applicant Sachin Parasram Wagh has filed present application for grant of regular bail under section 483 of BNSS, 2023 in crime no.7/2026 for the offence punishable under sections 80(2), 108, 3(5) of BNS 2023, registered with Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim.

2] Heard learned advocate for the applicant/accused and learned APP for the State. Perused the case diary. Also heard complainant and his learned advocate.

3] The learned advocate for the applicant submitted that the FIR no.7/2026 dated 03/01/2026 has been registered at Risod police station, against four accused persons. The present applicant is arrayed as accused no.1. He is arrested on 07/01/2026. The case of the prosecution is that the sister of the complainant namely Pooja who was the wife of present applicant, expired due to hanging herself at her matrimonial house. The complainant on 01/01/2026 received a phone call from the present applicant and informed about the incident. Accordingly, the complainant went to village Lehni, matrimonial house of deceased Pooja. The complainant saw deceased Pooja hanged herself and therefore, he lodged report against the present applicant and others. It is submitted that the allegations mentioned in FIR are vague, general

and omnibus in nature and no specific overt act is attributed to the present applicant. That all co-accused have already been released on anticipatory bail and regular bail by this Court. The investigation is completed and the charge sheet has already been filed, therefore, no purpose would be served by keeping the present applicant behind bars. It is submitted that the earlier bail application of present applicant was rejected because at that time investigation was in progress. But now charge sheet is filed. Hence, there is change in circumstances. The applicant is bread earner of his family. He is ready to undertake to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by the Court. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

4] The learned APP filed say vide Exh.07 and strongly objected the application on the ground that the offence is serious in nature. If applicant is released on regular bail, he may pressurize the prosecution witnesses and may tamper the evidence. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

5] The complainant also filed say and submitted that the present applicant is the main accused in this crime. The nature of offence is serious and is in respect of the women. Hence, he prayed to reject the application.

6] I have gone through the record. It appears that the present applicant/accused is arrested on 07/01/2026. Since then

he is in behind bar. The investigation is over and charge sheet has been filed in the Court. It will take time to commence the trial. Hence, further detention of the applicant/accused is not necessary. Applicant/accused is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions imposed by the court. The apprehension of the prosecution that accused might tamper with the prosecution evidence or may pressurize the informant and witnesses can be taken care of by imposing certain conditions. Considering the facts and circumstances applicant deserve to grant bail application on stringent condition. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Applicant/accused **Sachin Parasram Wagh** be released on bail on executing PR. Bond of Rs.25,000/- with surety in the like amount, in Crime no.7/2026 for the offence punishable under sections 80(2), 108, 3(5) of BNS 2023, registered with Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim.
- 3) Applicant is directed to attend the Court regularly and not to tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- 4) Applicant/accused shall not pressurize the complainant and the witnesses in any manner.
- 5) Hamdast allowed.
