Rashmi v. State

The applicant/accused Rashmi Ganesh Hendre has filed this application for grant of regular bail under section 483 of BNSS, 2023 in Crime no.980/2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 310(2), 318(4), 333, 140(2), 61(2), 324(4), 351(3), 352 of BNS 2023 and section 4/25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered with Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim wherein she has moved this application for grant of interim bail.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicant/accused and learned APP for the State.

3. Learned advocate for the applicant submitted that previously on two occasion, the regular bail application of the applicant came to be rejected. However, applicant has filed this application on the ground that the applicant is a student of F.Y.B.A. at Deogiri College, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar and the examination of F.Y.B.A. is starting from 01/04/2026 and applicant is willing to appear said exam. It is submitted that applicant is scholar student. Hence, prayed for allow the application and thereby grant the interim bail from 31/03/2026 to 05/04/2026.

4. Learned APP have filed say overleaf the application and submitted that the applicant has not filed any supportive

documents except the hall ticket. It is submitted that the applicant has not filed any affidavit in that regard. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

5. After going through the record it appears that earlier two bail application is rejected by this Court. It appears that examination of B.A.F.Y. is started from 01/04/2026 to 04/04/2026. Hence, considering the submission of learned advocate for the applicant, interim bail granted to the applicant till 06/04/2026. Hence, following order.

ORDER

- 1) The application for interim bail (Exh.8) is hereby allowed till 06/04/2026.
- 2) The applicant Rashmi Ganesh Hendre is released on P.R. bond of Rs.25,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount in crime no.980/2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 310(2), 318(4), 333, 140(2), 61(2), 324(4), 351(3), 352 of BNS 2023 and section 4/25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered with Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim.
- 3) Issue intimation to the concerned police station and the concerned J.M.F.C. accordingly.
- 4) Hamdast allowed.
