Rashmi v. State

The applicant Rashmi Ganesh Hendre has filed present application for grant of regular bail under section 483 of BNSS, 2023 in crime no.980/2025 for the offence punishable under sections 310(2), 318(4), 333, 140(2), 61(2), 324(4), 351(3), 352 of BNS 2023, and S.4/25 of Arms Act,1959 registered with Police Station Risod, Tq.Risod, Dist. Washim.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicant/accused and learned APP for the State. Perused the case diary.

3. Learned advocate for the applicant/accused submitted that this is the first bail application of applicant after filing of charge sheet before the Court. It is submitted that on the basis of complaint lodged by Laxmi Sitaram Khanzode, to P.S. Risod on 14/12/2025 against the applicant and others the aforesaid crime came to be registered. It is alleged by the complainant that her family was looking for bride for her son Deepak through accused no.1 and the accused no.1 were introduced to a girl named Radha Tupe. On 10/12/2025, accused no.1 arrived with the applicant and others. The complainant's family pressured into performing a hurried marriage ceremony that same evening. In exchange for the marriage, the family paid Rs.2 lakh to the mediator i.e. accused no.1 Savita Kakade.

4. It is further submitted that the brother of the present

applicant arrived and tried to take the applicant away. When the family grew suspicious and questioned the applicant, she confessed her real name was Rashmi Ganesh Hendre and that the marriage was set organized by a group to defraud the family for the money. The complainant's family asked for their money back, but on 14/12/2025 a group of 8 to 10 people arrived and attacked the complainant's father house and destroyed the property and two motorcycle and abducted the complainant's husband namely Sitaram Khanzode at gunpoint and threat of wife and demanding the girl to return to them. It is submitted that the applicant is student of F.Y.B.A. The applicant is resides with her widow mother and paralyzed younger brother. She has responsibility of her old aged mother. It is submitted that applicant is innocent and falsely implicated in this crime and all the allegations leveled against the applicant are false and baseless one. The applicant is arrested on 15/12/2025 and she was remanded in MCR on 19/12/2025, this shows that the custodial interrogation of the applicant is not necessary. Applicant has no any criminal antecedents. Applicant is ready to abide by all conditions imposed by the Court. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

5. The learned APP filed say vide Exh.05 and opposed the application on the ground that the offence is serious in nature. The applicant and others by making conspiracy commit the offence. The present applicant is one of the main accused. The applicant falsely stated her name Radha Tupe and performed her marriage hence, the offence arose. If applicant released on bail, she may pressurize the complainant and prosecution witnesses. Still 11 accused are yet to be traced. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

6. I have gone through the record. It appears that earlier bail applications of this applicant was rejected by this Court on the count that the investigation is in progress. It also appears that accused Shantaram Khanduji Kharate and Rahul Dilip Mhaske were released on default bail by JMFC, Risod on 18/03/2026.

7. On perusal of record it appears that the present applicant is arrested on 15/12/2025. After charge sheet, she moved an application for interim bail and this Court granted her interim bail application till 06/04/2026. Thereafter, time to time application has been filed for extension of interim bail which was also granted by this Court. From the record it appears that co-accused are released on bail. So also, charge sheet is filed in the trial Court. Applicant/accused is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions imposed by the court. Considering the facts and circumstances applicant deserve to grant bail application on certain condition. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) The interim bail granted on 30/03/2026 to the applicants/accused Rashmi Ganesh Hendre is hereby confirmed on same terms and conditions.
- 3) The applicant is directed to attend the Court on each and every date.
- 4) Hamdast allowed.
