Applicant/accused no.1 Aniket @ Anil Yuvraj Mainkar has filed present application for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 registered with Washim City police station in crime No.903/2025 under Sections 108 r/w. 3(5) of BNS 2023.

2. It is the case of the prosecution is that the complainant Chhaya Suresh Dhule lodged report that her daughter namely Ashwini Suresh Dhule (victim) and the applicant were in love hence, she performed engagement of her daughter Ashwini with the applicant. Thereafter, the applicant; and his mother in law and father in law laid down the condition that the wedding must take place in a Vatane Mangal Karyalaya. But since the financial condition of complainant is not sound hence, she wants to perform the marriage in simple way. On that count, dispute arose in between them. Thereafter on 05/12/2025 the applicant made phone call to Ashwini and he raised dispute with her, he also assaulted her. Therefore, she took the medicine which used to kill rat. During treatment, Ashwini Dhule died in the hospital.

3. It is submitted by the learned advocate for the applicant that on perusal of FIR it reveals that the incident happened on 05/12/2025 but the complainant lodged report in police station on 06/12/2025. Said delay in lodging report is not explained by the prosecution. The applicant is falsely implicated in this crime. There was love relations in between the deceased and applicant. But over trifle ground, the father and mother raised dispute therefore, deceased fed up

with his harassment and ended her own life. He further submitted that there is no direct involvement of present applicant in this crime, his reputation would be ruined. Hence, it is necessary to grant him Regular bail. The applicant is ready to abide by all terms and conditions imposed by the Court while granting him bail. Hence, prayed to allow bail application.

4. The learned APP and investigating officer have filed say vide Exh.04 and objected the application on the ground that the applicant is responsible for the demise of deceased. The applicant took mobile of deceased with him. Said mobile is yet to be seized. The applicant gave ill-treatment and harassed the deceased and refused to marry with her hence, she constrained to commit suicide. If applicant is granted bail, he may pressurized the witnesses. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

5. After going through the record it appears that this applicant filed anticipatory bail application No. 393/2025 before the Sessions Court, Washim which was rejected by the Court on dated 01.01.2026. Thereafter he approached the Hon'ble High Court Nagpur Bench Nagpur for anticipatory bail and the said Criminal Bail Application No. 10/2026 was rejected by the Hon'ble High Court in respect of this applicant on 14.01.2026. It also appears that after filing charge-sheet this applicant again filed anticipatory bail application No.122/2026 before the District and Sessions Court, Washim in R.C.C. No. 54/2026 which was also rejected by the Sessions Court. Thereafter accused was arrested on 06.05.2026 and till this date he is behind bar.

6. From the record it appears that there is specific allegation

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against the applicant that he quarreled with the deceased and therefore deceased consumed the poison use for killing rats and this allegation of beating just prior to consumption of poison. It appears that primi-facie involvement of this accused in this crime. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

Application stands rejected.
