

**Atro. Spl. Case No.12/2026
State Vs. Sanket and Ors.**

Order below Exh.3

This is an application filed by applicants no.1 to 5 for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 in Crime No.633/2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023 and section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities), Act, 1989 registered with Police Station Malegaon, Tq.Malegaon, Dist.Washim.

2. Heard learned advocate for the applicants/accused, learned advocate for the complainant/victim and learned APP for the State. Perused the record.

3. The learned advocate for the applicants/accused submitted that applicants are permanent resident of village Mungla, Tq.Malegaon, Dist.Washim. The applicants have no criminal antecedents. The complainant Sachin Mangilal Kamble lodged report against them alleging that applicants have beaten him and abused him on caste. It is submitted that Sub Divisional Officer, Washim had given notice under section 35(3) of BNSS 2023 and released the applicants on certain condition. Now investigation is completed and charge sheet has been filed by investigating officer. The applicants are ready to abide by all the terms and conditions imposed by the Court. Hence, prayed for releasing them on regular bail.

4. Learned APP and investigating officer have filed say vide Exh.4 and strongly opposed the application. It is submitted that the

offences leveled against the applicants/accused are serious in nature. The applicants/accused had beaten the complainant and abused him on caste. If applicants are released on bail, they may pressurize the complainant and witnesses. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

5. I have gone through the record it appears that the injury certificates issued by Rural Hospital, Malegaon, Dist.Washim shows that the injury caused to complainant Sachin Mangilal Kambleare simple in nature. The investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed in the Court. It will take time to commence the trial. The accused are already released by giving them notice under section 35(3) of BNSS, 2023. The apprehension of learned APP can be taken care of by imposing certain conditions on the applicants. Applicants/accused are ready to abide by all the conditions imposed by the Court. Considering the facts and circumstances, bail can be granted by imposing some conditions. Hence, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Applicant/accused no.1.Sanket Nandkishor Bhandurge, 2.Vaibhav Gajanan Bhandurge, 3. Vaibhav Mahadev Raut, 4. Satyanarayan Sakharam Raut and 5.Sagar Ramdas Bali be released on PR. Bond of Rs.25,000/- each with one solvent surety in the like amount in Crime No.633/2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023 and section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered with Police Station Malegaon, Tq.Malegaon, Dist.Washim.

3. Applicants/accused are directed to attend the Court regularly and not to tamper with the prosecution evidence.
4. Hamdast allowed.
