

**IN THE COURT OF PRINCIPAL DISTRICT JUDGE, WASHIM.**

**Order Below Exh. 01**

1. By the present application, the applicant is praying for condonation of delay in preferring appeal against the order passed below Exh. 5 in RCS No. 31/2023 pending before Ld. Civil Judge (Jr. Dn.), Risod.
2. It is the case of the applicant that the opponents had preferred the suit before the Ld. Trial Court and had prayed for interim reliefs therein. The said interim relief was granted on 04/09/2023. As the applicant was gone around for his livelihood, he could not contact his advocate. Hence, appeal is delayed of 565 days. Hence, prayed for condonation of delay.
3. The opponent Nos. 2 to 8 have not filed their reply. The opponent No. 9 is served, but she has not appeared in the proceedings. The opponent No. 1 filed reply opposing the application contending that there is no explanation given and no just and sufficient cause is made out. The application is filed after thought to mentally harass. Hence, the application be rejected.
4. Heard both sides. Considered the submissions advanced.
5. On perusal of the impugned order, it is seen that the Advocate for the applicant was duly instructed to argue on interim application and accordingly, he has so argued in September-2023. From September-2023 till March-2025, the appellant has not made inquiry with the Advocate. There is some responsibility of the parties to make inquiry. Being absent for livelihood is one thing and not inquiring about the order itself is another. Considering the same,

present applicant has not inquired about the proceedings itself and after nearly two years has woken up. Apparently, the suit is still pending. Considering overall circumstances of the case, the applicant is grossly negligent in present matter and no just and sufficient cause is made out to condone the delay. Hence, I pass the following order -

**ORDER**

- 1) The application is hereby rejected.
- 2) Application disposed off, accordingly.
