1) The accused Shaikh Jahir Shaikh Siddiqui is not seen to be traceable and his whereabouts are not know. Considering the same

(a) **Issue NBW against the accused.** The NBW be served firstly within 15 days and secondly within next 15 days if not executed firstly.

(b) After the second non execution of NBW within 7 days, the concerned police are requested to publish in local daily newspaper of the last known address of residence calling upon the proclaimed offender to appear before the court for trial within 30 days from the date of publication or the trial will commence in his absence.

(c) After publication of the newspaper notice, after 40 days to inform the relative or friend by RPAD or by affixing it on the last known address of the accused the copy of the said public notice and intimate to the relatives or friends about the commencement of trial after 15 days thereof.

(d) Issue Notice to the advocate on record of the accused about the commencement of the trial and/or, provide legal aid through LADC.

(e) It is clarified that on such completion of the above procedure the court shall proceed to examine the witnesses and record deposition and such deposition shall be read in evidence against the proclaimed offender on the inquiry into or in trial for the offence with which he is charged subject to provision of Section 356 (Notification of State Required) of BNSS.

2) Police to verify and report, if the witnesses are traceable and available.
