ORDER BELOW EXH.14.

The learned counsel for D.H. filed this application under section 151 of Civil Procedure Code for amendment in the darkhast.

2] The learned counsel for D.H. submits that while preparing the Darkhast, a typographical error crept in. The principal outstanding amount was wrongly typed as sub total amount as Rs.81,202/- and total amount due Rs.81,635/-. It is further submitted that as per the original Award, the correct figures are Sub Total Amount Rs.83,902/- and Total Amount due Rs.84,335/-. Said mistake is bonafide and no prejudice would be caused to the J.D., if the correction is allowed. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

3] The J.D. though appeared but not filed his say.

4] I have gone through the record. It appears that the correction sought is of a clerical/typographical nature and is in accordance with the original Award. No prejudice will be caused to the J.D. and the correction is necessary for proper adjudication and execution of the decree. In view of the above, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] The D.H. is permitted to carry out the necessary amendment in the Darkhast as prayed for and file amended copy of it.
- 3] No order as to costs.
