ORDER BELOW EXH.3

1. This is an application for grant of regular bail u/s 439 of Cr.P.C.
2. According to applicant Police Station,Risod have registered crime No.780/2021 under section 302 and 506 of I.P.C.
3. On 4/11/2021 complainant Kamal Pawar lodged report stating that marriage between her daughter Jayshree (deceased) and accused was performed prior to 15 years. Her husband used to beat her and drove her out of his house. On 8/11/2021 deceased told her that on earlier date there was a quarrel between she and accused person and because of this in the afternoon at 2 p.m accused beat her by wooden rafter because of which she sustained injury to her head, hand and legs. Thereafter, she took her daughter to government hospital, Risod. They referred her Civil Hospital,Washim but as those were Diwali days complainant took her daughter to the hospital of Dr.Biyani. Doctor treated her. On 4/11/2021 in the night her daughter fail unconscious so took her to the Civil Hospital, Washim. However, doctor declared her as a dead. On the basis of above complaint offence came to be registered.
4. According to advocate of the applicant, applicant is having two daughters and one son. Except applicant there is nobody to look after them. Applicant is in jail since 5/11/2021. Their marriage was performed prior to 15 years. Investigation is completed chargesheet is

also filed. Hence, prayed for grant of bail.

5. As against this learned APP objected the application contending that there is ample evidence like oral D.D to mother of deceased. Daughter of deceased is also eye witness. Delay is also explained. Deceased was residing with the applicant. Hence, prayed for rejection of bail.

6. On considering rival submission of the parties on going through the record it is clear that present applicant is in jail since 5/11/2021. Chargesheet is already filed. Investigation is completed. No purpose will be served by keeping him behind the bar. Moreover, applicant has look after his three children. There is no body to look after them. Considering all these facts application deserves to be allowed. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application Exh.3 is allowed.
2. Accused Banti @ Ajay Laxman Jadhav be released on executing P.R.bond of Rs.25,000/- with one or two solvent surety of like amount, in crime No.780/2021 U/s 302 and 506 of I.P.C registered at Police Station Risod.
3. Hamdust allowed.

 - i) Applicants shall not tamper the prosecution evidence.
 - ii) They shall not commit such type of offence again.
 - iii) They shall attend the police station as and when required by the Investigating Officer and shall co-operate him.
- 3) Bail before Lower Court.
