

**IN THE COURT OF SESSIONS JUDGE, WASHIM.**

**Order Below Exh. 01**

(Dated 10/04/2026)

1. By the present application, the applicant is praying for condonation of delay in preferring the revision application for challenge to the issuance of process.
2. It is contended that there was no knowledge of passing of the said order and they got the order on 14/10/2025 and therefore, present proceedings have been preferred on 11/11/2025. Hence, apparent delay.
3. The said application is challenged by the complainant contending that the present proceeding has been filed to protract proceeding. The present applicant had already knowledge of the criminal proceedings and was looking after the said proceeding in order to protract the proceedings.
4. Heard both sides. Considered the submissions advanced.
5. On perusal of the impugned order, it is seen that the impugned order is passed on 09/12/2024. The proceeding before the Hon'ble High Court which has mentioned of the present case is of April-2024. Thus, although, knowledge of the pending proceedings can be attributed to the applicant, knowledge of the impugned order cannot be attributed to the applicant. It is well settled principle that in case of proceeding with regard to revision application against issuance of process, period of limitation would start from date of knowledge.
6. On perusal of the documents filed, the date of summons issued was returnable on 03/11/2025. Thus, even if that is considered, the record shows that it was delivered on 14/10/2025. Thus, in such

cases, the period of revision or limitation for filing revision would fall from the knowledge of the order. Hence, there is no delay in preferring the revision application. Hence, I pass the following order -

**ORDER**

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) Delay is hereby condoned
- 3) Office to register revision as per rules.
- 4) Application disposed off, accordingly.
