Meena Suresh Jaiswal+2 Vs. Nil

ORDER BELOW EXH.1

This is an application under Sec.56(2) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Act 2000, read with Adoption Regulation 2022.

2. Applicant no.1 is the adoptive mother and applicant Nos.2 and 3 are biological parents. Husband of applicant No.1 has expired on 25/09/2006. The adoptive child is grandson of applicant No.1 and applicant No. 2 is her nephew i.e. son of her real sister. Applicant No.1 has registered her name with designated portal of Central Adoption and Resource Authority [CARA]. The said authority has issued pre-approval letter to Applicant No.1 and directed to approach competent authority for further proceeding.

3. Heard Ld. advocate for applicants. He has placed reliance on the order passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in OSWP/1085/2023 order dated 16/06/2023. The Hon'ble Bombay High Court observed that Judicial Officers of Courts in question dealing with adoption matters must continue to do so until final disposal of petition. Ld. advocate submitted that said petition is still pending and order of High Court is still in existence, hence this application before this Court is maintainable and this Court has power to decide said application.

4. Affidavit of applicant Nos.1 to 3 are at Exh.11 to 13. The application and pre-approval letter of Central Adoption and Resource Authority [CARA] is produced at Exh. 33 and 34. Consent letter of the adoptive mother and the biological parents for the purpose of relative adoption is at Exh.21. Family background report of child and biological parents is at Exh.22. Birth certificate of the child and Aadhaar cards of the

adoptive mother, biological parents and the child are at Exh. 20, 23, 38, 39 and 24 respectively. Certificate issued by the District Women and child Welfare Board dated 28/03/2025 is at Exh. 25. Citation notice dated 18/01/2025 published in Daily Punya Nagri is at Exh. 27. Self sworn marriage affidavit of biological parents is at Exh.36. Family tree of adoptive mother and biological parents is at Exh.35. Consent letter of adoptive child is at Exh.40. Medical certificates of of the adoptive mother and the biological parents and adoptive child are at Exh.42 to 45. Income certificate of adoptive mother and income tax return are produced on record at Exh 37 and 42 which shows that Sanjay Shinde has income of Rs.4,96,000/- per year. The adoptive mother close relative of adoptive son i.e she is grandmother of adoptive son. Therefore the adoption is in the welfare of adoptive child.

5. On verification of the prospective adoptive mother is found economically, mentally and physically in sound position and the adoption is in the welfare of adoptive child who is close relative of adoptive parents. Hence, following order is passed :-

ORDER

- (i) Application is hereby allowed.
- (ii) Prospective mother Meena wd/o Suresh Jaiswal is permitted to adopt male child namely Ayush Sunil Jaiswal.
- (iii) Prospective mother Meena wd/o Suresh Jaiswal is declared as adoptive mother male child namely Ayush Sunil Jaiswal.
- (iv) Prospective adoptive mother is directed to maintain male child namely Ayush Sunil Jaiswal in future in a proper way and good manner and take care of his future education and development by all means.
