

**ORDER BELOW EXH.14 IN Spl.D. NO.7/2024**  
**Vishwas Tayde Vs. Gajanan Maharaj Prasark Mandal & Others**  
**(CNR No.MHWS020001762024)**

J.D. No.2 has filed the objection as per Section 47 of CPC. It is submitted by the J.D. that he was not serving as Head Master of concern school. He was authorized to sign the salary deeds during 01/11/2023 to 20/01/2024. Therefore, the applicant/objector can not be held responsible to execute the order of school tribunal and to pay the back wages.

2] On the other hand D.H. has filed say at Exh.18. It is submitted by the D.H. that he has filed the present proceeding for the recovery of back wages Rs.12,74,750/- as the J.D. No.2 was serving as Head Master. Hence, he was added in the present proceeding. The J.D. not has not forwarded the bill of D.H. Therefore, the outstanding salary amount remained to be disbursed. The school in question is already closed. The J.D. No.2 was serving as Head Master at the relevant time. Therefore, he can submit the explanation. It is necessary to recover the outstanding amount from J.D. No.2. Therefore, the objection/application is liable to be rejected.

3] Heard both sides. The D.H. has filed documents along with list Exh.4 at serial No.1 the judgment and order in Appeal No.4/2022 delivered by School Tribunal Amravati is filed on record. It appears that said order was passed on 25/08/2023 and by virtue of that order the directions were given to the J.D. No.1 so also the Head Master of J.D. No.1 school to reinstate the D.H. The directions were also given to the J.Ds. to pay the full back wages from 09/09/2021 till reinstatement of

D.H. The D.H. has filed letter issued by J.D. No.3 dated 02/11/2023. It appears that by virtue of said letter the JD. No.3 has authorized J.D. No.2 to sign Salary bills of J.D. No.1. It is specifically mentioned in the said letter that J.D. No.3 has authorized the J.D. No.2 to sign the bills from 01/11/2023 to 31/01/2024. Admittedly, at the time of passing order by School Tribunal the J.D. No.2 was not authorized to sign the paybills. Therefore, considering this fact it is clear that the J.D. No.2 was not authorized to sign the pay bills. Moreover, the J.D. has produced the letters issued by J.D. No.3 dated 20/11/2023 and 05/07/2023. From the said letters it can be easily gathered that J.D. No.2 is already transferred to another school. Considering this fact certainly the J.D. No.2 is not responsible to forward any bill on the date of order of school tribunal nor he can forward the bill on today because he is already transferred. Hence, considering all these aspects I came to the conclusion that the present proceeding can not continue against the present J.D. i.e. Rameshwar Madhav Gote. Hence, I pass following order -

**ORDER**

- 1] Application/objection is allowed.
- 2] The present proceeding is dismissed against the J.D. No.2.
