

ORDER BELOW EXH.21 IN Reg.Darkhast No.15/2023
Kiran Padghan & Anr Vs. Natthu Suryabhan Padghan

D.H. has filed the present application. Heard learned counsels for the D.H. J.D. is absent. So also his counsel repeatedly called till 05.00 p.m. but absent. Say not filed. It is submitted by learned counsel for the D.H. that outstanding amount against J.D. is Rs.11,19,497/-. Therefore, for recovery of the said amount it is necessary to issue directions to the employer of the J.D. to deduct the amount from his salary and to deposit the same in Court. It is also submitted that the gross salary of J.D. is Rs.62,935/-. After the deduction net pay of J.D. is 40,441/-. Therefore, considering this fact the salary of JD be attached. Considering this fact and considering the outstanding amount I came to the conclusion that amount of Rs.10,000/- per month can be deducted from the salary of J.D. Therefore, I pass following order-

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] The salary of J.D. is hereby attached to the tune of Rs.10,000/- per month.
- 3] Issue letter to the employer of J.D. to deduct Rs.10,000/- per month from the salary of J.D. until the total deduction of outstanding amount of Rs.11,19,497/- or until further direction of this Court.
