Perused the application, documents filed on record by the plaintiffs. Heard learned counsel for the plaintiffs. Considering facts and circumstances of the case and considering the record prima-facie it appears that it will be just and proper to grant ad-interim exparte injunction in favour of plaintiff and against the defendant. Therefore, I pass following order-

ORDER

- 1] The ad-interim exparte injunction is granted in favour of plaintiffs and against the defendant Nos.1 to 18. The defendant Nos.1 to 18, their labourers, family members, relatives, agents or any other persons claiming through them are hereby temporarily restrained from using the road passing through the field of plaintiffs till the appearance of defendants in the present suit and till filing reply of Exh.5 by them.
- 2] The plaintiffs to comply the mandate of Order 39 Rule 3 of CPC.
- 3] EP and SB allowed. Issue notice to the defendants as to why the ad-interim exparte injunction which is granted in favour of plaintiff shall not be confirmed.
